On Tuesday, a joint session of the House of Representatives and the Senate heard Governor Culver deliver his Condition of the State address. The address focused on the natural disasters of 2008 and the current budget crisis we are experiencing. We are currently facing a \$779 million shortfall. This is a staggering number. In my estimation, this budget shortfall cannot solely be blamed on the natural disasters of 2008 and the current economic crisis. The past General Assembly (2006-2008) increased spending in the State of Iowa by approximately one billion dollars! The entire budget for the state is approximately six billion dollars. To increase spending by 20 percent in only two years is ridiculous. This is not how Iowa families or businesses behave and your state government should not either. The budget will be the central issue facing the General Assembly this legislative session. Count on me to use this motto, "government should be run like a business and we need to do more with less." This is what Iowa families are facing in this difficult time and your state government should follow suit.
